Definitions

Number of Pregnancies: Total number of pregnancies in a specified age group.

Pregnancy Rate: The number of pregnancies occurring to females in a specified age group per 1,000 females in the specified age

Percent Repeat Pregnancies: The number of pregnancies that are not first pregnancies per 100 pregnancies.
