

# A SNAPSHOT OF ADOLESCENT HEALTH & WELL-BEING

# FRANKLIN COUNTY

## WELL-BEING

- The unemployment rate in Franklin is 4% while the Georgia average is 3.9%.
- 24% of children in Franklin are living in poverty, while the Georgia average is 20%.
- 39% of children in Franklin live in single parent families while the Georgia average is 34%

## SEXUAL & REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

- The teen pregnancy rate in Franklin is 19.5 per 1,000 while the Georgia is 9.9 per 1,000.
- The teen birth rate in Franklin is 20.8 per 1,000, compared to the Georgia average of 16.5 per 1,000.
- 14% of teen mothers in Georgia are giving birth to a second child.
- The STD incidence of youth in Franklin is 20.7 per 1,000, compared to the Georgia average of 28.3 per 1,000.

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## MENTAL HEALTH

- As in Georgia, 6% of youth in Franklin expressed that they've seriously considered attempting suicide.

## PHYSICAL HEALTH & NUTRITION

- As in Georgia, the average of youth who consumed alcohol in the last 30 days in Franklin is 8%.
- 8% of youth in Franklin consumed alcohol in the last 30 days which is the same average as Georgia.
- The obesity rate in Franklin is 41% while the Georgia average is 34%.
