Developed in 2015, TMI Georgia goes a long way in filling gaps in sexual health education for thousands of youth in Georgia. TMI's appeal is its convenience, confidentiality, and wealth of information—from where to find health clinics to what to expect when visiting one. Teens and young adults can also get their questions answered anonymously and privately in real time by trained health educators and professionals. For many youth in rural communities where youth-serving clinics are nonexistent, TMI-GA may be the only resource they have for access to sexual health information.
