LiFT

Linking Families & Teens is a 6-hour workshop for youth (ages 13-19) and their parents/caregivers. In this workshop, youth and their caregivers work together to increase healthy relationships and communication skills around sexual health topics. LiFT participants are engaged in follow up text messages for 12 weeks following the program. **Earn a \$50 Incentive for attending!**

INclude is a 3-hour comprehensive sex education workshop made just for LGBTQ+ youth and allies. In this workshop, youth are provided with information, resources, and tools for protecting themselves against STIs and unintended pregnancies.
