## Knowing your HIV status is a vital step in protecting your health and preventing the spread of HIV.

The CDC recommends that everyone between the ages of 13 and 64 get tested for HIV at least once as part of routine healthcare. For those who are sexually active, testing every 3 to 6 months is encouraged. Early detection leads to better health outcomes, timely treatment, and reduced risk of transmission.

In Georgia, young people between the ages of 15 and 24 represent some of the highest rates of new HIV diagnoses.

The good news: HIV is manageable with proper care. Getting tested is simple, and knowing your status puts you in control of your health. Free or low-cost, confidential testing is available throughout Georgia.

Medications like PrEP (pre-exposure prophylaxis) and PEP (post-exposure prophylaxis) make HIV prevention easier and more effective than ever before.
